



Would you help the Nunda Historical Society carry out its work to preserve, promote, and present our local history? We are currently preparing to build a pavilion in the rear area of our property.

The pavilion will benefit the Society in several ways.

- 1) It will allow us to expand our historical programming. We hope to create a series of summer local history workshops for area residents including the children who attend the summer recreation program next door at Kiwanis Park.
- 2) The 40 X 24' pavilion will include a 10 X 24' foot enclosed storage area that will provide badly needed general storage space.
- 3) The Society will not have to rent large tents for Homecoming and History Day events.
- 4) The pavilion will be the new home of two important artifacts - the six foot wide grinding wheel from the old Woodworth Knife Works, and the Nunda made school bell from the Oakland School House.
- 5) We can restart our annual garage sale, a successful fund raiser in the past.
- 6) We will also carry out much needed improvements to the drainage in our parking lot and clear the southeast corner of our property during the work.

Although we will be using funds from our treasury, we hope to raise at least \$15,000 for the project. An anonymous Society member has offered to **match every dollar up to \$7,000!**
